# FY 2026 Budget Development/Prioritization Input

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## **Federal Budget Process**

- 1. Each Department submits their budget to the Office of Management and Budget (OMB)
- 2. OMB consolidates all Department budgets
- 3. President approves the budget and submits to Congress
- 4. Sub-committees develop bills
- 5. Appropriation Committee approves Bills and sends for floor vote
- 6. President signs budget into law

### **Building a Budget**

- Start with lifecycle planning because it reflects our priorities
- Identify and quantify difference or changes in priority
- Categorize work:
  - 1. Maintain safe and compliant operations
  - 2. Meet regulatory milestones
  - 3. Enable needed infrastructure
  - 4. Continue ongoing cleanup activities
- Sequence work within the funding targets and program performance
- Quantify impacts if necessary



### **OREM's priorities**

- Closure of ETTP
- Demolition of excess contaminated facilities at ORNL and Y-12
- Infrastructure to enable cleanup
  - Mercury Treatment Facility
  - CERCLA waste disposal facility
- Disposition of U-233 material
- Disposition of legacy transuranic contact-handled (CH) / remote-handled (RH) debris and sludges
- Maintain and operate facilities at ORNL and Y-12
