

ECA OVERALL PROJECT PROCESS

Project Plan proceeding as outlined in Scope of Work

Build capacity in communities interested in consent-based siting to ensure they have the information - and informed representatives to meaningfully engage on the issues a community will address as a potential host of a nuclear waste facility.

Facilitate deeper engagement and (re)create momentum through grants for qualifying communities that demonstrate readiness to begin localized education and outreach.

Key Developments

- Featured consent-based approach to siting nuclear facilities in Borsele, The Netherlands -ECA New Nuclear Forum, May 8, 2024
- Hosting meeting, "Building a Business Case and Identifying Economic Opportunities for Consent-Based Siting," July 17-18, 2024, in Washington, D.C.
- Cross-consortia collaboration on community grants and progress, Boise State University and Clemson University
- Developed/released applications for individual grants to local communities that demonstrate meaningful interest in building targeted capacity or hosting a nuclear waste storage or disposal mission using consent-based siting.
- Awarding three community grants, May 2024





Key Observations

- Recognized need for legislative change <u>BUT</u> new emphasis on what can be done NOW
- Existing Congressional interest (if not champions)
- Hesitancy to engage (Lack of clarity? Fear of commitment?)
- Need for additional information on what "interim storage" looks like
- Need to talk about "opportunities" that can be paired with nuclear waste missions
- Need for more education on transportation (Promote existing safe transportation record?)
- Recognize need to address linkage and plans for an integrated waste management system.
- Interest in reprocessing and potential impact
- Opportunity to leverage interest in advanced nuclear technologies to introduce discussions about the back-end of the fuel cycle.
- Ongoing efforts needed to build trust
