Based on my review of the information concerning the proposed action, as NEPA Compliance Officer (authorized under DOE Policy 451.1), I have made the following determination:

Description:

A9 Information gathering, analysis, and dissemination

Information gathering (including, but not limited to, literature surveys, inventories, site visits, and audits), data analysis (including, but not limited to, computer modeling), document preparation (including, but not limited to, conceptual design, feasibility studies, and analytical energy supply and demand studies), and information dissemination (including, but not limited to, document publication and distribution, and classroom training and informational programs), but not including site characterization or environmental monitoring. (See also B3.1 of appendix B to this subpart.)

Rationale for determination:

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) is proposing to provide funding to the University of Massachusetts Amherst (UMass Amherst) to establish the Academic center for Reliability and Resilience of Offshore Wind (ARROW) for the purpose of addressing infrastructure, transmission, and supply chain challenges seen when scaling up offshore wind technologies.

Award activities would be limited to intellectual, academic, and analytical activities. Specifically, the following entities would be responsible for educational activities, engagement, and computational and simulation research: UMass Amherst (Amherst, MA), UMass Lowell (Lowell, MA), UMass Dartmouth (North Dartmouth, MA), Northeastern University (Boston, MA), Morgan State University (Baltimore, MD), Johns Hopkins University (Baltimore, MD), University of Puerto Rico (Mayaguez, PR), and Clemson University (Clemson, SC). All facilities are preexisting purpose-built facilities for the type of work to be conducted for this award. Facility modifications, outdoor work, and ground disturbance would not be required.

DOE has considered the scale, duration, and nature of proposed activities to determine potential impacts on resources, including those of an ecological, historical, cultural, and socioeconomic nature. DOE does not anticipate impacts on these resources which would be considered significant or require DOE to consult with other agencies or stakeholders.

Any work proposed to be conducted at a federal facility may be subject to additional NEPA review by the cognizant federal official and must meet the applicable health and safety requirements of the facility.

NEPA PROVISION

DOE has made a final NEPA determination.

Include the following condition in the financial assistance agreement:

Award activities covered by this NEPA determination are limited to intellectual, academic, and analytical activities. If outdoor work, ground disturbing activities, and/or facility modifications are proposed, completion of an additional NEPA review would be required before the associated work can commence.

There are no extraordinary circumstances related to the proposed action that may affect the significance of the environmental effects of the proposal.

This proposal is not connected to other actions with potentially significant impacts (40 CFR 1508.25(a)(1)), is not related to other actions with individually insignificant but cumulatively significant impacts (40 CFR 1508.27(b)(7)), and is not precluded by 40 CFR 1506.1 or 10 CFR 1021.211 concerning limitations on actions during preparation of an environmental impact statement.

The proposed action is categorically excluded from further NEPA review.
