Dear FERGAS Staff,

On April 9, 2021, in DOE/FECM Order No. 4688, the U.S. Department of Energy, Office of Fossil Energy and Carbon Management (“DOE/FECM”), granted to Vista Pacífico LNG, S.A.P.I. de C.V. (“Vista Pacífico” or “VPLNG”) a long-term, multi-contract authorization to export natural gas to Mexico and to re-export liquefied natural gas (“LNG”) from its proposed VPLNG Mid-Scale Project to nations that have free trade agreements with the United States requiring national treatment in the trade of natural gas (“FTA countries”). On December 20, 2022, in DOE/FECM Order No. 4929, the DOE/FECM, granted to Vista Pacífico a long-term, multi-contract authorization to export natural gas to Mexico and re-export LNG to non-Free Trade Agreement Nations. One of the conditions of the DOE/FECM’s authorizations is that Vista Pacífico file semi-annual written reports (on or before April 1 and October 1 of each year) describing the progress of the planned VPLNG Mid-Scale Project. Vista Pacífico hereby submits the semi-annual report covering the period from April 1, 2024 through September 30, 2024.

VPLNG has made progress on the technical front with selection of a vendor/partner for the technology and configuration of the project. VPLNG has finalized the Pre-FEED (front end engineering design) for the liquefaction project and marine facilities and is engaging engineering, procurement and construction (EPC) firms to begin FEED.

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On permitting matters, VPLNG has begun the filing process for several key permits in Mexico, including the long term export permit with the Ministry of Energy (“SENER”). VPLNG remains engaged with the agencies and expects to apply for the remaining permits in 2024.

VPLNG has also made significant commercial progress having reached agreement on commercial terms with Mexico’s Federal Electricity Commission (“CFE”) for long-term gas supply arrangements. Vista Pacifico is scheduled to begin operations by 2029.
