Based on my review of the information concerning the proposed action, as NEPA Compliance Officer (authorized under DOE Policy 451.1), I have made the following determination:

Description:

A9 Information and dissemination

Information gathering (including, but not limited to, literature surveys, inventories, site visits, and gathering, analysis, audits), data analysis (including, but not limited to, computer modeling), document preparation (including, but not limited to, conceptual design, feasibility studies, and analytical energy supply and demand studies), and information dissemination (including, but not limited to, document publication and distribution, and classroom training and informational programs), but not including site characterization or environmental monitoring. A11 Technical advice and assistance to organizations

Technical advice and planning assistance to international, national, state, and local organizations.

Rationale for determination:

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) is proposing to provide federal funding to the National Association of State Energy Officials (NASEO) to facilitate discussions between Louisiana state agencies, local governments, communitybased organizations, industry, and other key local stakeholders regarding permitting and siting challenges and considerations for hydrogen fueling infrastructure.

Award activities would occur over two budget periods (BP). BP1 would include project management and planning, advisory group meetings, identification and strategy to overcome local barriers, and implementing solutions to permitting and siting through Louisiana state and local dialogue. BP2 would include project management and planning, advisory group meetings, development of state policy, programmatic, and regulatory framework, publishing of a final clean hydrogen fueling station "program in a box" which is intended to help states and local governments replicate key aspects of successful programs and create replicating solutions and sharing resources for overcoming local barriers and implementing solutions to permitting and siting.

Award activities would occur at NASEO in Arlington, VA; Louisiana Clean Fuels Inc. in Baton Rouge, LA; Greater New Orleans Development Foundation in New Orleans, LA; and the Great Plains Institute in Minneapolis, MN.

Award activities would be limited to intellectual, academic, or analytical in nature and would occur entirely within existing research and development facilities that are purpose-built for the type and scale of activities being proposed. No change in the use, mission, or operation of existing facilities would arise out of this effort.

DOE has considered the scale, duration, and nature of the proposed activities to determine potential impacts on sensitive resources, including those of an ecological, historical, cultural, and socioeconomic nature, and found no effects that would be expected to result from the proposed project activities.

There are no extraordinary circumstances related to the proposed action that may affect the significance of the environmental effects of the proposal.

The proposed action has not been segmented to meet the definition of a categorical exclusion. This proposal is not connected to other actions with potentially significant impacts (40 CFR 1508.25(a)(1)), is not related to other actions with individually insignificant but cumulatively significant impacts (40 CFR 1508.27(b)(7)), and is not precluded by 40 CFR 1506.1 or 10 CFR 1021.211 concerning limitations on actions during preparation of an environmental impact statement.

The proposed action is categorically excluded from further NEPA review.
