Please accept the following comment on the above-referenced project:

I am opposed to the LNG export proposal by Pieridae Energy, which is seeking approval to export gas using the M&N pipeline.

This project should not receive approval. The export of natural gas is not in the public interest. It will result in higher, not lower gas prices, and will profit a small handful of people, not the general public. In general, use of this nation's natural gas resources should be minimized to reverse global warming. Certainly, any gas that is extracted by the dangerous method of hydraulic fracturing should <code>_only_</code> be used for domestic use, and primarily to bridge energy use until renewable resources may be developed. Export projects like this one undermine our nation's ability to adapt to the the realities of the future.

I am opposed to fracking and to any infrastructure that supports it.

Your agency should not be giving permits for projects that are linked (such as this LNG terminal) when the pipelines that are proposed to feed it have not even been approved yet (and I hope they never are).

Support projects that do not contribute to climate change, and promote renewable energy in whatever way you can.

I would also like to comment that the period for comments on this proposal ought to be extended. I only learned today that this comment period would be ending today -- four hours before it closes -- and I have been following pipeline issues closely.
