Hi

Due to the limited publicity, we only learned of the application today, and request an extension of the public comment period to comment.

I am the hazardous waste coordinator in Deerfield MA, am on the Open Space Committee and a prior member of the Planning Board.

I was extremely disturbed to see the lack of awareness of the company who was proposing to put the pipeline under a contaminated rail yard, contaminated aquifer, an active quarry operations, etc.

In addition to the potential impacts of the siting of the pipeline itself, natural gas is a greenhouse gas 86 times more potent than CO<sub>2</sub>. Studies show that leaks of gas from drilling, transmission and distribution cause environmental impacts similar to coal. Thus, I cannot support impacts to the local and global environment for the export of natural gas.
