It has come to my attention that the Department of Energy is proceeding to fast track an application that will have a tremendous affect on my small community, Ashfield, Massachusetts. We are looking at potential natural gas pipeline infrastructure to be situation through our town and towns in the state of New York and New Hampshire in the form of pipeline built by Tennesee Gas Pipeline/Kinder Morgan, a multi-billion dollar, profit-driven corporation. Any authorization of export contracts is not in the public interest.

No "public good" is served by these export projects. In fact they inflict much public harm because the extraction of fracked gas turns public's property into sacrifice zones; the infrastructure to transport and process this unnatural gas turns public property into sacrifice zones; exporting our resources reduces what is available to the American public; the public's property stands to be taken by eminent domain for private corporate profit; the public assumes all the risk and the private sector reaps all the benefits.
