I am writing to request that you extend the comment period for FE Docket No. 14-179-LNG. I just learned of this over the weekend, and I think such a serious matter as allowing export of gas for 20 years needs close scrutiny.

Some of this gas coming from United States would be sources from shale gas obtained through hydraulic fracturing. This type of extraction is extremely risky to the water supply. Once we damage our water supply, it is not necessarily easy to restore it. The risk we incur in order to obtain this gas which would flow through the M&N pipeline to this export terminal is NOT in the public's best interest.
