ORDER VACATING AUTHORIZATION TO EXPORT NATURAL GAS TO CANADA

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 3246-A

On February 27, 2013, in DOE/FE Order No. 3246, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted long-term authorization to J.P. Morgan Commodities Canada Corporation (JPMCCC) to: (i) export up to 320,000 thousand cubic feet (Mcf) of natural gas per day, plus applicable fuel, to Canada from November 1, 2012, through October 31, 2022; and (ii) export up to 120,000 Mcf per day of natural gas, plus applicable fuel, to Canada from November 1, 2013, through October 31, 2023, pursuant to a gas purchase contract with Statoil Natural Gas LLC.

On February 19, 2015, Mercuria Commodities Canada Corporation notified DOE/FE that it had purchased JPMCCC, effective October 1, 2014. As the current authorization is no longer

needed, Mercuria Commodities Canada Corporation requests that DOE/FE vacate Order No. 3246, retroactively effective on February 19, 2015. DOE/FE finds good cause to do so.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the authorization to export natural gas to Canada granted to JPMCCC in DOE/FE Order No. 3246 is hereby vacated, effective February 19, 2015.
