ORDER VACATING BLANKET AUTHORIZATION TO IMPORT AND EXPORT NATURAL GAS FROM AND TO CANADA

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 3308-A

On July 18, 2013, in DOE/FE Order No. 3308, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to J.P. Morgan Commodities Canada Corporation (JPMCCC) to import and export up to a combined total of 200 Bcf of natural gas from and to Canada over a two-year term beginning on September 24, 2013, and extending through September 23, 2015.

On February 19, 2015, Mercuria Commodities Canada Corporation notified DOE/FE that it had purchased JPMCCC, effective October 1, 2014. As the current authorization is no longer

needed, Mercuria Commodities Canada Corporation requests that DOE/FE vacate Order No. 3308, retroactively effective on February 19, 2015. DOE/FE finds good cause to do so.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the authorization to export natural gas to Canada granted to JPMCCC in DOE/FE Order No. 3308 is hereby vacated, effective February 19, 2015.
