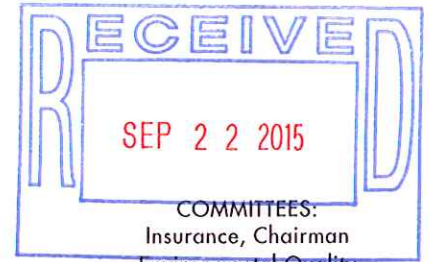

**Re: Cameron LNG LLC, FE Docket No. 15-67-LNG NFTA**

Dear Deputy Assistant Secretary Paula Gant,

I am writing in strong support of Cameron LNG's application to increase their approved export volumes by 152 Bcf per year (approximately 2.95 MTPA) of domestically produced LNG, to meet the facility's maximum capacity.

The Cameron LNG export facility, currently under construction, is providing a boost to Louisiana's local and regional economy through indirect increases in resource development, an enhanced tax base, direct and indirect job creation and increased economic activity. Over 140 permanent new quality jobs will be created at Cameron LNG, many of these prior to the end of construction, and these jobs will directly benefit Louisiana's economy.

Louisiana's regional economy will likely see new additional employment opportunities from the increased international markets for US domestically produced shale gas. Cameron's international partners, Mitsubishi, Mitsui and ENGIE (formerly GDF Suez) are also providing much needed foreign international investment into our economy.

Cameron LNG's multi-billion dollar investment in Southwest Louisiana is a good success story for Louisiana.
