ORDER VACATING BLANKET AUTHORIZATION TO IMPORT LIQUEFIED NATURAL GAS FROM VARIOUS INTERNATIONAL SOURCES BY VESSEL

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 3405-A

On February 27, 2014, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to JPMorgan LNG Co. (JPMorgan) in DOE/FE Order No. 3405 to import liquefied natural gas (LNG) from various international sources by vessel, up to a total of the equivalent of 600 Bcf of natural gas over a two-year term beginning on April 6, 2014, and extending through April 5, 2016.

On July 24, 2015, JPMorgan notified DOE/FE that it is no longer engaged in the business activity associated with DOE/FE Order No. 3405. JPMorgan therefore requests that DOE/FE vacate Order No. 3405 on the date this Order is issued. DOE/FE finds good cause to do so.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the authorization to import LNG from various international sources granted to JPMorgan in DOE/FE Order No. 3405 is hereby vacated, effective September 17, 2015.
