A RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT FOR CAMERON LNG'S REQUEST TO DOE TO APPROVE ADDITIONAL 9.97 MTPA CAPACITY FOR EXPORT TO NON-FTA COUNTRIES.

WHEREAS, the Cameron Parish Policy Jury supports the existing construction of Cameron LNG's three-train liquefaction facility in Hackberry, LA and Cameron LNG's Expansion Project which will add two additional liquefaction trains and one additional full containment LNG storage tank to the liquefaction project; and,

WHEREAS, the Cameron LNG Expansion Project will allow the company to export additional LNG from low-cost reliable US LNG supplies to international markets; and,

WHEREAS, the Expansion Project is capable of increasing LNG production by 9.97 million tonnes per annum (mtpa), or approximately 1.41 billion cubic feet per day of domestically produced liquefied natural gas (LNG); and,

WHEREAS, the US Department of Energy has approved Cameron LNG application to export the additional capacity from the Expansion Project to all current and future Free Trade Agreement countries and Cameron LNG's application for approval for non-Free Trade Agreement countries is pending in FE Docket 15-90-LNG; and,

WHEREAS, the Cameron LNG export facility, currently under construction, is providing a boost to Louisiana's local and regional economy through indirect increases in resource development, an enhanced tax base, direct and indirect job creation and increased economic activity; and,


WHEREAS, Cameron LNG has been a longstanding key member of the Cameron Parish community and has provided quality jobs, invested in our community through education, non-profits, health and the environment and contributed to our economic development programs; and,

WHEREAS, the Cameron LNG Expansion Project will create an additional 50 permanent new quality jobs and lengthen the amount of time that the peak construction jobs (over 3000 jobs) will be maintained at the facility, thus directly providing benefits to Louisiana's economy and specifically, Cameron Parish; and,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Cameron Parish Policy Jury does hereby support Cameron LNG's Expansion project and in particular, Cameron LNG's request to DOE to approve the additional 9.97 mtpa capacity for export to non-FTA countries, and the Secretary is authorized to send this resolution to the US Department of Energy.

THEREUPON, the above resolution was duly adopted and approved this 29th day of September, 2015.
