ORDER AMENDING BLANKET AUTHORIZATION TO IMPORT LIQUEFIED NATURAL GAS FROM CANADA BY TRUCK, IN ISO CONTAINERS ON LINER CARGO VESSELS, AND ON BULK OCEAN-GOING VESSELS

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 3720-A

On October 5, 2015, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) issued DOE/FE Order No. 3720, which granted Crowley Petroleum Distribution, Alaska LLC blanket authorization to import liquefied natural gas (LNG) from Canada by truck, in ISO containers on liner cargo vessels, and on bulk ocean-going vessels without ISO containers, up to a combined total volume equivalent to 2.12 billion cubic feet of natural gas over a two-year term beginning on October 5, 2015, and extending through October 5, 2017.

On October 9, 2015, DOE/FE was notified that the company name was mistakenly identified in the Application. The correct name of the authorization holder is "CPD Alaska LLC," not Crowley Petroleum Distribution, Alaska LLC. CPD Alaska LLC asks DOE/FE to amend DOE/FE Order No. 3720 to reflect its correct name.

Upon review, we find good cause to grant this request. Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, it is hereby ordered that DOE/FE Order 3720 is amended to change the name of the authorization holder to CPD Alaska LLC. All other terms and conditions of DOE/FE Order 3720 shall remain in full force and effect.
