- -- Low \$; High Risk; High Return

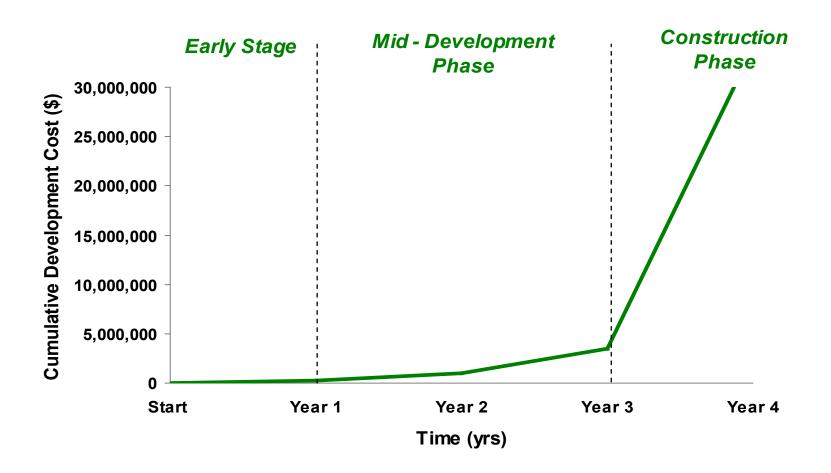
Mid Stage
