## ORDER VACATING AUTHORIZATION TO EXPORT NATURAL GAS TO MEXICO

## DOE/FE ORDER NO. 3695-A

On August 13, 2015, the Office of Fossil Energy of the Department of Energy (DOE/FE) granted blanket authorization to Toyota Motor Engineering & Manufacturing North America (TEMA) in DOE/FE Order No. 3695, authorizing TEMA to export natural gas to Mexico over a two-year term beginning on August 1, 2015, and extending through July 31, 2017.

On January 12, 2016, TEMA notified DOE/FE that it has canceled the contract to supply natural gas to Toyota Motor Manufacturing de Baja California, and no longer needs the blanket authorization set forth in DOE/FE Order No. 3695. TEMA therefore requests that DOE/FE vacate Order No. 3695 retroactively, effective January 13, 2016. DOE/FE finds good cause to do so.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the authorization to export natural gas to Mexico granted to TEMA in DOE/FE Order No. 3695 is hereby vacated, effective January 13, 2016.
