ORDER VACATING AUTHORIZATION TO IMPORT AND EXPORT NATURAL GAS FROM AND TO CANADA

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 3531-A

On October 16, 2014, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to Fortuna (US) L.P. (Fortuna) in DOE/FE Order No. 3531 to import and export up to a total of 75 billion cubic feet of natural gas from and to Canada over a two-year term beginning on December 21, 2014, and extending through December 20, 2016.

On February 3, 2016, Fortuna notified DOE/FE that it has ceased its import and export activity and no longer needs the current blanket authorization. Fortuna therefore requests that DOE/FE vacate Order No. 3531 retroactively, effective January 31, 2016. DOE/FE finds good cause to do so.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the authorization to import and export natural gas from and to Canada granted to Fortuna in DOE/FE Order No. 3531 is hereby vacated, effective January 31, 2016.
