## ORDER VACATING AUTHORIZATION TO IMPORT NATURAL GAS FROM CANADA

## DOE/FE ORDER NO. 3706-A

On September 17, 2015, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to Barclays Bank PLC (Barclays) in DOE/FE Order No. 3706 to import up to 1.22 billion cubic feet of natural gas from Canada over a two-year term beginning on September 1, 2015, and extending through August 31, 2017.

On February 11, 2016, Barclays notified DOE/FE that it has ceased its import activity and no longer needs the current blanket authorization. Barclays therefore requests that DOE/FE vacate Order No. 3706 retroactively, effective January 31, 2016. DOE/FE finds good cause to do so.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the authorization to import natural gas from and to Canada granted to Barclays in DOE/FE Order No. 3706 is hereby vacated, effective January 31, 2016.
