## ORDER VACATING AUTHORIZATION TO IMPORT AND EXPORT NATURAL GAS FROM AND TO MEXICO

## DOE/FE ORDER NO. 3834-A

On May 20, 2016, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to Houston Pipe Line Company LP (Houston) in DOE/FE Order No. 3834 to import and export up to 102.2 billion cubic feet of natural gas from and to Mexico over a two-year term beginning on March 1, 2016, and extending through February 28, 2018.

On June 15, 2016, Houston, by letter, requested DOE/FE vacate DOE/FE Order No. 3834 since it duplicates the authority granted to Houston in DOE/FE Order No. 3761. DOE/FE finds good cause to grant Houston's request.
