DOE/FE Order No. 3885

On August 11, 2016, Bluewater Gas Storage, LLC (Bluewater) filed an application with the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) requesting blanket authority to import up to 30 billion cubic feet (Bcf) of natural gas from Canada and to export up to 30 Bcf to Canada, pursuant to transactions that have terms of no longer than two years. On September 8, 2016, in DOE/FE Order No. 3885, DOE/FE authorized Bluewater to import and export from and to Canada up to a combined total of 30 Bcf of natural gas for a two-year term, which begins on September 18, 2016, and extends through September 17, 2018.

Because Bluewater's application requested authorization to import 30 Bcf from Canada and authorization to export 30 Bcf to Canada, rather than authorization to import and export a combined total of 30 Bcf, and because the requested authorization is not inconsistent with the public interest, the following corrections will be made to Order No. 3885:

(1) In Section I of the Order (DESCRIPTION OF REQUEST), the first sentence will be changed to read:


On August 11, 2016, Bluewater Gas Storage, LLC (Bluewater) filed an application with the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) under section 3 of the Natural Gas Act (NGA) for blanket authorization to import up to 30 billion cubic feet (Bcf) of natural gas from Canada and to export up to 30 Bcf of natural gas to Canada.

(2) In the section titled ORDER, the first sentence of Ordering Paragraph A will be changed to read:

(A) Bluewater is authorized to import up to 30 Bcf of natural gas from Canada and to export up to 30 Bcf of natural gas to Canada, pursuant to transactions that have terms of no longer than two years.

All other Findings and Ordering Paragraphs in DOE/FE Order No. 3885 remain in full force and effect.
