ORDER VACATING AUTHORIZATION TO IMPORT AND EXPORT NATURAL GAS FROM AND TO CANADA

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 3714-A

On September 17, 2015, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to TransCanada Pipelines Limited (TransCanada) in DOE/FE Order No. 3714 to import and export up to 195.6 billion cubic feet of natural gas from and to Canada over a two-year term beginning on November 1, 2015, and extending through October 31, 2017. TransCanada submitted a request on October 5, 2016 asking DOE/FE to vacate DOE/FE Order No. 3714 contingent and effective upon the approval and effective date of replacement authority. TransCanada sought replacement authority by application filed October

5, 2016 in DOE/FE Docket No. 16-157-NG. TransCanada asked that the replacement authority take effect on November 1, 2016.

For the reasons stated therein, DOE is today issuing in DOE/FE Order No. 3911 granting the replacement authority requested in Docket No. 16-157-NG. Accordingly, DOE/FE finds good cause to also grant TransCanada's request to vacate the authorization issued in DOE/FE Order No. 3714.

Therefore, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the authorization to import and export natural gas from and to Canada granted to TransCanada in DOE/FE Order No. 3714 is hereby vacated, effective November 1, 2016.
