## ORDER VACATING AUTHORIZATION TO IMPORT AND EXPORT NATURAL GAS FROM AND TO CANADA

## DOE/FE ORDER NO. 3619-A

On April 1, 2015, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to Constellation Energy Services, Inc. in DOE/FE Order No. 3619 to import and export up to a combined total of 100 billion cubic feet of natural gas from and to Canada over a two-year term beginning on April 1, 2015, and extending through March 31, 2017.

On October 3, 2016, Constellation Energy Services, Inc. notified DOE/FE that it has ceased its import and export activity and no longer needs the current blanket authorization.

Constellation Energy Services, Inc. therefore requests that DOE/FE vacate Order No. 3619.

DOE/FE finds good cause to do so.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the authorization to import natural gas from and to Canada granted to Constellation Energy Services, Inc. in DOE/FE Order No. 3619 is hereby vacated, effective October 31, 2016.
