1. Section I of DOE/FE Order No. 3987 (Order), issued on February 10, 2017, in the above-referenced docket is hereby corrected to read as follows:

On January 4, 2017, Repsol Oil & Gas USA, LLC (Repsol) filed an application with the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) under section 3 of the Natural Gas Act (NGA)¹ for blanket authorization to import and export up to a combined total of 75 billion cubic feet (Bcf) of natural gas from and to Canada via pipeline. The applicant requests the authorization be granted for a two-year term beginning on December 30, 2016.² Repsol is a Texas limited liability company with its principal place of business in The Woodlands, Texas. Its parent companies are Repsol E&P USA Holdings Inc. and Repsol USA Holdings Corporation.

2. Ordering Paragraph A is hereby corrected to read as follows:

² On January 4, 2017, Repsol requested their authorization begin on December 30, 2016 via email.

A. Repsol is authorized to import and export up to a combined total of 75 Bcf of natural gas from and to Canada, pursuant to transactions that have terms of no longer than two years.

This authorization shall be effective for a two-year term which began on December 30, 2016, and extends through December 29, 2018.

- 3. Ordering Paragraph D is hereby correct to read as follows:
- D. The first monthly report required by this Order is due not later than February 28 2017, and should cover the reporting period from December 30, 2016, through January 31, 2017.

 All other portions of Order No. 3987 remain unchanged.
