The National Nuclear Security Administration's Building 3 Remediation, Restoration, and Upgrade Project

The Building 3 Remediation, Restoration, and Upgrade Project developed and executed an innovative and aggressive acquisition strategy resulting in outstanding project performance on schedule and 12 percent under budget. A small business design-build subcontract was used to complete renovation of a 78,000 square foot office building containing beryllium. Salvageable materials were recycled, benefitting the overall cost and reducing landfill waste. In addition, this project achieved a Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) "Silver" certificate. This renovation yielded a functional yet flexible office space allowing off-site personnel to relocate to one space, saving more than \$4 million per year.
