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ORDER VACATING AUTHORIZATION TO  
IMPORT AND EXPORT NATURAL GAS FROM AND TO CANADA

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 3701-A

On September 15, 2015, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to Talisman Energy USA, Inc. in DOE/FE Order No. 3701 to import and export up to a combined total of 75 billion cubic feet of natural gas from and to Canada over a two-year term beginning on November 1, 2015, and extending through October 31, 2017.

On January 4, 2017, Talisman Energy USA, Inc. notified DOE/FE that it no longer needs the current blanket authorization and therefore requests that DOE/FE vacate Order No. 3701. DOE/FE finds good cause to do so.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the authorization to import natural gas from and to Canada granted to Talisman Energy USA, Inc. in DOE/FE Order No. 3701 is hereby vacated, effective December 30, 2016.
