ORDER VACATING AUTHORIZATION TO  
EXPORT NATURAL GAS TO MEXICO

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 3795-A

On March 15, 2016, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to Energia del Caribe, S.A. (Energia del Caribe) in DOE/FE Order No. 3795 to export up to 18.8 billion cubic feet of natural gas to Mexico over a two-year term beginning on March 15, 2016, and extending through March 14, 2018.

On March 16, 2017, Energia del Caribe notified DOE/FE that it no longer needs the current blanket authorization effective November 28, 2016, and therefore requests that DOE/FE vacate Order No. 3795. DOE/FE finds good cause to do so.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the authorization to export natural gas to Mexico granted to Energia del Caribe in DOE/FE Order No. 3795 is hereby vacated, effective November 28, 2016.
