ORDER VACATING AUTHORIZATION TO EXPORT NATURAL GAS TO CANADA

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 3995-A

On March 7, 2017, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted long-term authorization to New England NG Supply Limited (New England NG) in DOE/FE Order No. 3995 to export up to 0.014 billion cubic feet per day of natural gas to Canada for a term of five years (60 months) beginning on the later of: (1) November 1, 2017, or (2) the first day of the month immediately succeeding the commercial in-service date of the Atlantic Bridge Project, as specified in Base Contract No. NAES23344, dated January 27, 2016, between New England NG and EQT Energy, LLC.

On June 23, 2017, New England NG requested that DOE/FE vacate DOE/FE Order No. 3995. DOE/FE finds good cause to do so.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the authorization to export natural gas to Canada granted to New England NG in DOE/FE Order No. 3995 is hereby vacated, effective June 29, 2017.
