I have participated in public committees overseeing the Elba Island LNG facility for well over ten years. The facility management has done a great job designing and developing the facility for LNG storage and transfer. They also built a new mooring and transfer facility that makes LNG carriers and other vessels safe and comfortable on the Savannah River.

When the LNG management requested approval and a permit for the land storage and transfer facility, several local groups reported that all the trucks required for construction would have a negative effect on the local community. They included several areas that were outside the facility danger zone. There have been absolutely no negative effects on our community during construction.

The Elba LNG facility management is professional and effective in working with local and regulatory organizations to coordinate safe and effective operations both in the port and on land.
