Dear Ms. Sweeney:

Freeport LNG Expansion, L.P., FLNG Liquefaction, LLC, FLNG Liquefaction 2, LLC, and FLNG Liquefaction 3, LLC (collectively, "FLEX") filed an application ("Application") with the U.S. Department of Energy, Office of Fossil Energy on January 4, 2018 in the above-referenced docket. In the Application, FLEX requested blanket authorization to export domestically-produced liquefied natural gas ("LNG") in an amount up to the equivalent of 782 billion cubic feet of natural gas on a cumulative basis over a two-year period, commencing on the earlier of the date of first short-term export or September 1, 2018, to any nation with the capacity to import LNG via ocean going carrier and with which trade is not prohibited by U.S. law or policy. The LNG that is the subject of the Application will be exported from the Freeport LNG Liquefaction Project which is currently under construction at the Freeport LNG Terminal on Quintana Island, Texas. Through this letter, FLEX amends the Application to reflect an updated export term commencing on the date of the commencement of export of commissioning volumes (but no later than six months from the end of the third quarter 2019).
