ORDER VACATING AUTHORIZATION TO
IMPORT NATURAL GAS FROM CANADA,
AND TO EXPORT NATURAL GAS
TO CANADA AND MEXICO

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 4221-A

On July 31, 2018, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to Certarus (USA) Ltd. (Certarus) in DOE/FE Order No. 4221 to import up to 0.2 billion cubic feet (Bcf) of natural gas from Canada, to export up to 0.18 Bcf of natural gas to Canada, and to export up to 0.1 Bcf of natural gas to Mexico over a two-year term beginning on July 31, 2018, and extending through July 30, 2020.

On June 21, 2019, Certarus requested that DOE/FE vacate DOE/FE Order No. 4221, effective July 1, 2019. Certarus notified DOE/FE that it no longer needs the current authorization and requests that it be vacated.¹ DOE/FE finds good cause to do so.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the authorization to import natural gas from Canada and export natural gas to Canada and Mexico granted to Certarus in DOE/FE Order No. 4221 is hereby vacated, effective July 1, 2019.
