ORDER VACATING AUTHORIZATION TO
IMPORT AND EXPORT NATURAL GAS FROM AND TO CANADA AND MEXICO

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 4350-A

On February 22, 2019, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to Societe Generale Energy LLC in DOE/FE Order No. 4350 to import and export up to a combined total of 9 billion cubic feet of natural gas from and to Canada and Mexico over a two-year term beginning on February 22, 2019, and extending through February 21, 2021.

On July 19, 2019, Societe Generale Energy LLC, notified DOE/FE that it no longer needs the current blanket authorization. Societe Generale Energy LLC therefore, requests that DOE/FE vacate Order No. 4350.¹ DOE/FE finds good cause to do so.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the authorization to import and export natural gas from and to Canada and Mexico granted to Societe Generale Energy LLC in DOE/FE Order No. 4350 is hereby vacated, effective July 1, 2019.²
