

## Touring the Fernald Preserve PLEASE BE CAUTIOUS

During remediation and restoration of the Fernald Preserve, every effort was made to remove and dispose of all demolition debris. However, weather erosion, and earth moving activities occasionally reveal small pieces of debris that were not visible during remediation and restoration efforts. Examples of construction debris include pieces of concrete, rebar, clay tile and metal.



All areas of the site have been certified clean for the intended use as an undeveloped park with the exception of the Converted Advanced Wastewater Treatment Facility and the South Field Valve Houses which are still in use. To ensure the site is enjoyed consistent with the cleanup completed and to allow the ecological restoration of the site to successfully proceed, please adhere to the following:

Obey all signs and postings

Stay on marked trails and observation points

Do not handle or remove any debris

Please inform any member of the Fernald Preserve staff if you find any debris so that it can be safely and properly disposed of by the appropriate personnel.
