ORDER VACATING AUTHORIZATION TO EXPORT NATURAL GAS TO MEXICO

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DOE/FE ORDER NO. 4434-A

On September 3, 2019, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to Border Energy Management LLC (Border Energy Management) in DOE/FE Order No. 4434 to export up to 380 billion cubic feet of natural gas to Mexico over a two-year term beginning on September 3, 2019, and extending through September 2, 2021.

On January 12, 2021, Border Energy Management notified DOE/FE that it no longer requires the current blanket authorization. Border Energy Management therefore requests that

DOE/FE vacate Order No. 4434 effective December 31, 2020.¹ DOE/FE finds good cause to do so.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the authorization to export natural gas to Mexico granted to Border Energy Management LLC in DOE/FE Order No. 4434 is hereby vacated, effective December 31, 2020.
